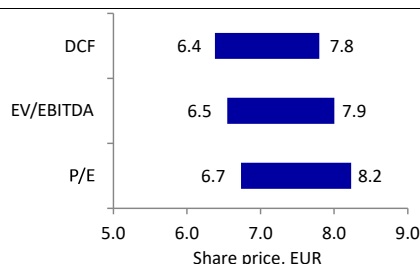

We expect a good Q2 2021 result

Organic growth has likely been healthy and we forecast 8.1% y/y revenue growth for Scanfil for Q2. The company's Q2 EBIT margin will most likely be close to its long-term target of 7%, according to our estimates. For 2021, we forecast 11.6% y/y revenue growth and a 6.8% adjusted EBIT margin. The share price has been rewarded with a very good run, jumping 65% in one year. Our fair value range for Scanfil is EUR 6.5-8.0, based on three equally weighted valuation approaches – DCF, EV/EBITDA and P/E. The company's 2021E-22E P/E and EV/EBITDA multiples combined are now ~20% above those of the peer group. The valuation discount was about 20% in 2012-20, but we see no reasons for Scanfil to trade below the valuation of its peers.

Second quarter results to be published on 6 August

Scanfil's peer Incap said in late July that EMS market demand had remained strong and that the strong trend was continuing. The Nordic EMS peer Kitron said that its order backlog was 9% higher in late June than a year ago. For Scanfil, we forecast Q2 net sales of EUR 168m, while the market (Refinitiv) consensus is EUR 166m. Our forecast for Q2 operating profit is EUR 11.6m (consensus: EUR 11.4m). As Scanfil upgraded its 2021 guidance in June 2021, we expect it will leave guidance unchanged in conjunction with the Q2 report. Scanfil currently guides for 2021 net sales of EUR 630-680m and adjusted EBIT of EUR 41-46m. With our 2021E sales of EUR 664m and adjusted EBIT of EUR 45m, we are slightly above the midpoint of the guidance range.

Scanfil CMD on 14 September

As the overall performance has been good for several years, Scanfil could even raise its long-term financial targets at its CMD in September. Our 2023E net sales of EUR 714m is already above the targeted EUR 700m. Furthermore, our H2 2021E EBIT margin of 7% equals the current long-term target.

Main risks related to the length of current economic cycle

We upgrade our 2021E-23E net sales by 1% and EBIT by 2%. High raw material prices should not be a problem for Scanfil. In conclusion, we expect profitability to remain good and revenue growth to be strong. The main risks are related to overall industrial activity and how long the current economic upturn will last. As a manufacturing services company, Scanfil's success depends on its customers and how competitive their product portfolios are in each market.
