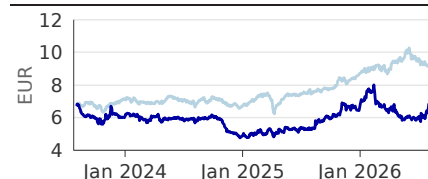

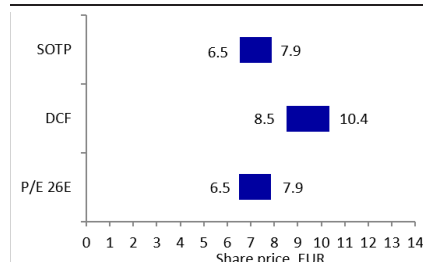

Favourable market environment for Telko

Q2 net sales and clean EBITA were above our expectations. Favourable pricing supported the Telko segment, but the market environment has remained somewhat soft in the ESL Shipping segment. Aspo maintained its outlook, guiding for a y/y EBITA improvement in 2026. The company's guidance is not challenging, and we believe Aspo could even upgrade it in H2 2026. Our new estimates support a broader fair value range of EUR 7.1-8.7 (6.7-8.2), based on an equal weighting of our DCF, P/E and SOTP valuations. Aspo was not able to sell the ESL Shipping segment at high multiples; therefore, no immediate value creation has materialised yet. In addition, the Telko segment is performing strongly in 2026, but similar adjusted EBITA margins might not be repeated in 2027. The Telko segment has a >12% annual average growth target for 2026E-30E, and its value creation is partly dependent upon acquisition prices and execution of its compounder strategy.

ESL Shipping segment's EBIT has deteriorated in 2023-26E

Net sales amounted to EUR 131m in Q2, compared to market consensus (LSEG) at EUR 124m. Organic revenue growth was 4%. Net sales growth (14%) in the Telko segment was supported by elevated chemical and plastic prices in Q2. Adjusted EBITA of EUR 10.8m from continuing operations came in above our forecast for EUR 7.2m. The Telko segment's adjusted EBITA was supported by a one-off-related inventory gain (EUR 2.0-2.5m) in Q2. Market sentiment has been weaker in the ESL Shipping segment, and in 2026, the segment could report its lowest adjusted EBIT in six years. The group-level full-year outlook remains unchanged, and Aspo guides for a y/y improvement in comparable EBITA in 2026. Our new group-level EBITA forecast is EUR 35m (2025: EUR 29.4m). We believe Aspo could even upgrade its full-year EBITA guidance in H2 2026.

Demerger is likely to take place by 31 December 2026

The separation of ESL Shipping and Telko is likely to release value by enabling each business to more effectively execute its own focused strategies and growth opportunities. However, a sale of ESL Shipping would have offered even more resources for the Telko segment to execute its compounder strategy, although industrial interest in buying ESL Shipping at a decent valuation might have been modest. ESL Shipping has abandoned its long-term comparable EBITA target of 14%. Instead, it now has an EBIT target of EUR >40m by 2030. This financial target indicates an adjusted EBIT CAGR of 28% for 2026E-30E. EBIT growth (above EUR 25m) is likely to be accompanied by a EUR 180m investment in new capacity. The Telko segment has a comparable EBITA margin target of above 8% for 2030. A favourable market environment should offer a flying start for the segment in 2026. Our margin forecast for the Telko segment is 7% for next year.
